Content, Technical & Link Audit — 9 Pages Reviewed

Prepared: July 14, 2026

Pages audited: Homepage, XM Review, JustMarket Review, Tickmill Review, FxPro Review, AvaTrade Review, Broker Forex Terbaik, Cara Main Forex. (HotForex Review's redirect loop, found during this audit, has since been fixed.)

Top-line summary

- **Two visual templates are live at once.** Homepage, XM, JustMarket, FxPro, AvaTrade(partially) and Broker Terbaik still run the old WordPress/HitMag theme; Tickmill, AvaTrade, and Cara Main Forex run a new theme. A visitor bouncing between broker reviews sees the site redesign itself mid-session.
- **A staging/dev domain is exposed in production** on the Tickmill page footer (see Technical Audit).
- **Recurring broken footer link** — "Broker Terbaik" in the new-theme footer points to /brokers/tifia-review/ instead of the best-broker roundup, on at least 3 pages.
- **Broker naming is inconsistent** across nav, URLs, and body copy — JustMarket vs JustMarkets, HotForex vs HFM vs HF Markets — which reads as unpolished and can confuse both users and Google.
- **Tickmill review page actively discourages the broker it's reviewing**, repeating a "we recommend XM/JustMarkets/FBS instead" disclaimer five times — undermines the page's own conversion purpose.
- A handful of clear typos and one instance of the wrong broker name copy-pasted into FxPro's copy.

1. Sitewide / Cross-Page Issues

Issues that show up on more than one of the audited pages — fix these first since they affect the whole site's consistency and trust signal.

1.1 Two site themes running simultaneously

CRITICAL

The homepage, XM, JustMarket, FxPro, and Broker Terbaik pages render the older WordPress + HitMag magazine theme (full sidebar, tag cloud, comment sections, "Popular/Comments/Tags" widget). Tickmill, AvaTrade, and Cara Main Forex render a completely different, newer theme (top nav bar, no sidebar, different footer with a 3-column link block). This matches the migration you've been running — but right now a visitor clicking from the homepage into an XM review, then into Tickmill, will see the whole site change layout, fonts, and navigation structure mid-journey. This is the single biggest thing hurting the site's professionalism right now.

1.2 Staging domain exposed in production footer

CRITICAL

The Tickmill review page footer reads "© 2026 darkorange-pigeon-140742.hostingersite.com" instead of forexmalaysia.com.my. This is a raw Hostinger staging hostname left in a live, indexable page — it's both an embarrassing/unprofessional look and a sign the migration content wasn't fully re-pointed to the live domain before publishing. Worth a full site-wide grep for that staging hostname before the next batch of pages go live.

1.3 "Broker Terbaik" footer link points to the wrong page

HIGH

On the new-theme pages (Tickmill, AvaTrade, Cara Main Forex), the footer's "Pautan Pantas" column has a "Broker Terbaik" link that points to /brokers/tifa-review/ — a single broker's review page — instead of /broker-forex-terbaik/, the actual best-broker roundup. This is a copy-paste/placeholder link that shipped to production and appears identically on all three new-theme pages checked, so it's a template-level fix, not a one-off.

1.4 Inconsistent broker naming across the site

MEDIUM

The same broker is named differently depending on where you look: **JustMarket** vs **JustMarkets** vs **Justmarkets** (nav label, URL slug "justmarket-review", and page H1 all disagree — the URL is singular, the brand and most on-page copy is plural). **HotForex** vs **HFM** vs **HF Markets** — three different names are used for what is presented as one broker across the homepage nav, the Tickmill/AvaTrade/Cara-Main-Forex nav, and the Broker Terbaik table. Recommend picking one canonical name (HFM is the broker's current legal/brand name) and one canonical URL slug, then 301-redirecting the old variants.

1.5 Old theme's sidebar recommends stale/off-topic content

LOW

Every old-theme page (homepage, XM, JustMarket, FxPro) carries the same "Popular Posts" sidebar widget, which surfaces a 2019 post ("Copytrade Update... 2019") and repeats the exact same 5 posts and 5 blog comments verbatim on every single page. This is default theme behaviour rather than a curated "popular" list, and it dilutes internal linking value — none of it is broker-review-specific or recent.

2. Broken Links & Redirect Issues

/brokers/tifia-review/ (mislabelled "Broker Terbaik")	Footer of Tickmill, AvaTrade, Cara Main Forex	Not a 404, but wrong destination — labelled as the best-broker list, actually opens one broker's individual review.
justforex.com/landing/... (referral link)	JustMarket review, step 1 of the account-opening walkthrough	Points to the old "JustForex" brand domain even though the rest of the page has already explained the broker rebranded to JustMarkets. Inconsistent with the justmarkets.pro login link used later on the same page.
AvaTrade footer "Broker Popular"	AvaTrade review footer	Uses raw WordPress query-string URLs (?page_id=407, ?page_id=1201, ?page_id=1207) instead of the clean permalinks used everywhere else (e.g. /brokers/xm-review/). Not broken, but inconsistent and bad for SEO/readability.
"Next Article" internal link	Broker Forex Terbaik page footer nav	Points to a 2021 seasonal promo ("Double Raya Rewards 2021 Oleh AvaTrade") — almost certainly a stale/expired campaign page being surfaced on a page dated 2026.
Broken images (placeholder SVGs)	Cara Main Forex — 3 inline images	Three images (labelled "img4", "konsep-forex", "deposit_cash_at_an_atm") resolve to blank transparent placeholder SVGs instead of real images — likely a lazy-load or CDN issue. Worth checking in an actual browser since a text fetch can't fully confirm rendering, but the placeholder data is a strong signal.

3. Page-by-Page Audit

3.1 Homepage

Theme: Old (WordPress/HitMag)

MEDIUM	Meta title "Forex Trading No #1 Malaysia" is a strong, unverifiable superlative claim — could read as spammy to both users and Google's quality raters. Consider softening to something you can substantiate.
MEDIUM	Nav lists both "HFM Review" and "Hotforex Review" as two separate menu items pointing to two different URLs — for what marketing material elsewhere on the site treats as the same broker. Either intentional (two distinct legal entities/eras) or a duplicate-content risk that should be merged with a redirect.
LOW	Front page is a chronological blog feed mixing forex broker content with unrelated personal-finance posts (old money/currency trivia, saving tips) going back to 2021. For an affiliate/SEO site, a more curated homepage (featured broker comparisons, recent reviews) would convert and rank better than a raw chronological dump.
LOW	Copyright year auto-updates ("© 2026") but several featured/"Popular" posts are from 2019–2021, undermining the sense of a maintained, current site.

3.2 XM Review

Theme: Old (WordPress/HitMag)

LOW	"1400 asset" should be "1,400 assets" — singular/plural mismatch in an otherwise well-written page.
LOW	One licence-number citation is glued onto the following sentence with no space/period: "...nombor lesen 120/10 di bawah nama Trading Point of Financial Instruments Ltd.7Y" — the stray "7Y" looks like a leftover footnote marker or paste artefact.
LOW	A few paragraphs in the "Adakah XM Sah" section are missing spaces between sentences/words (e.g. "...ramai trader tempatan sudah lama berbuat demikian." runs directly into the next bullet without a space in the source markup) — worth a proofread pass in the CMS editor, may just be a copy-fetch artifact but check rendering.
LOW	Solid page overall: clear regulator breakdown, a dedicated "is XM legal for Malaysian traders" section, and an FAQ block with schema-friendly Q&A; — this is your best-structured broker review of the ones audited and a good template for the others.

3.3 JustMarket Review

Theme: Old (WordPress/HitMag)

HIGH	Brand name is inconsistent within this single page: URL slug is "justmarket-review" (singular), nav label says "Justmarkets Review" (plural), the tag says "JustMarket Malaysia" (singular), and the on-page H1 says "JustMarket Malaysia Review" — but the body copy almost always calls the broker "JustMarkets" (plural). Pick one spelling and make the URL, title, and H1 agree with it.
MEDIUM	Typo: "Sesuai untuk posisi jangka panjang tanpa risiko caj tersembunyi" — missing the final "i" ("tersembunyi").
MEDIUM	Typo: "Sila muat naik dokumen pengesahan akaun dagagangan anda" — "dagagangan" should be "dagangan".
MEDIUM	Step 1 of the account-opening walkthrough links to justforex.com (the pre-rebrand domain) while the page's own text says JustForex is the old name and JustMarkets is current — and a later step links to justmarkets.pro for login. Two different domains for the same broker on one page will confuse readers and looks inconsistent.
LOW	"JustMarkets hanya tidak memberikan perkhidmatan kepada penduduk Belanda" — the double negative ("hanya tidak") is awkward phrasing; likely meant "tidak memberikan perkhidmatan kepada..." without "hanya".

3.4 Tickmill Review

Theme: New

CRITICAL	Footer shows the raw Hostinger staging domain instead of forexmalaysia.com.my — see Sitewide Issue 1.2.
HIGH	The page repeats, five separate times, a disclaimer steering the reader to XM/JustMarkets/FBS instead of Tickmill ("Tickmill masih okay, tapi kami mencadangkan broker lain seperti XM, JustMarkets dan FBS"). Once at the top makes sense as an editorial stance; five repetitions on a page whose job is to convert Tickmill sign-ups reads as actively discouraging the product being reviewed, and buries the page's own CTAs under a competing pitch. If the intent is genuinely to steer traffic elsewhere, consider merging this into Tickmill's overall verdict/kelemahan section instead of interrupting every account-type table.
MEDIUM	Several image blocks in the licensing section ("Badan Berkuasa Yang Memantau Tickmill") render with empty alt text and no visible image markdown — worth confirming these images are actually displaying to visitors.
LOW	Typo: "pihak Tickmill Malaysia... da support@Tickmill.com" — "da" should be "dan".
LOW	Support-hours line says live chat is available "Isnin 9 am - jumaat 10 pm" — a 13-hour daily window described elsewhere on the page as "5 hari seminggu sahaja" is also flagged under Kelemahan as slow/limited; the two mentions are consistent with each other but worth double-checking against Tickmill's current actual hours since this is the kind of detail that goes stale fast.

3.5 FxPro Review

Theme: Old (WordPress/HitMag)

HIGH	Wrong broker name used mid-page: "Justforex menyediakan empat jenis platform dagangan kepada pelanggan mereka iaitu FxPro (EDGE), MetaTrader 4, MetaTrader 5 dan cTrader." — this sentence is clearly about FxPro (it lists FxPro's own platforms) but names "Justforex" as the subject, almost certainly copy-pasted from the JustMarket review draft. This is the clearest copy-paste error found in the audit and should be fixed immediately since it actively misattributes the sentence.
LOW	Typo: "Broker FxPro adalah sebuah broker forex yang dikawal-selian dengan baik" — "dikawal-selian" should be "dikawal-selia".
LOW	Sokongan pelanggan Bahasa English/Bahasa Melayu appears twice with slightly different casing ("Bahasa English" is used instead of the more standard "Bahasa Inggeris") — minor, but a consistent style pass across all broker pages would read more polished.

3.6 AvaTrade Review

Theme: New (but footer still uses old raw query-string permalinks — see link table)

HIGH	Content is visibly stale for a page labelled "Review... Untuk Tahun 2026": it opens with "Pada ketika ini (tahun 2020), Avatrade mempunyai 200,000 pedagang..." — 2020 trader-count stats presented as current. Either update the figures or drop the specific numbers in favour of language that doesn't date the page.
MEDIUM	Regulator bullet list ends with a dangling empty bullet point (a lone "-" with nothing after it) — a leftover from editing that should be removed.
MEDIUM	Ends with a linked image promoting "Double Raya Rewards 2021" — a 5-year-old expired seasonal campaign — as if it were current content.
LOW	"Leverage untuk forex adalah 1:400, Gold 1:200, CrudeOil 1:100 dan tidak boleh diubah kecuali leverage untuk Forex" — slightly circular phrasing (says leverage can't be changed, then immediately says the Forex one can) — reads confusingly on first pass, worth a rewrite for clarity.

3.7 Broker Forex Terbaik (Best Brokers List)

Theme: Old (WordPress/HitMag)

MEDIUM	Internal inconsistency in the XM section: the intro sentence says XM offers "tiga jenis akaun dagangan" (three account types) — Micro, Standard, and Zero — but the bullet list two lines later says "empat jenis akaun" (four) — Standard, XM Ultra Low, Shares, and Micro. The account names also don't match between the two mentions ("Zero" vs "Ultra Low"/"Shares"). This same four-account structure is correctly described on the standalone XM review page, so this summary table just needs to be brought in line with it.
MEDIUM	Broker is called "HF Market" in the comparison table, "HF Markets" in the section heading, and "HFM" in the paragraph and spec table — three variants in one section (see also Sitewide Issue 1.4).
LOW	Typo/missing space: "Ya (Email, Live Chat, WhatsApp, Line danTelefon)" — "danTelefon" is missing a space.

LOW	"Next Article" footer nav points to a 2021 AvaTrade seasonal promo — see link table.
LOW	Good structural elements worth keeping/reusing: the intro clearly states evaluation criteria, each broker has a consistent pros list + spec table, and the numbered ranking is easy to scan — the underlying structure is sound, it just needs a proofread and a data refresh pass (2020/2021-era stats should be updated site-wide, not just here).

3.8 Cara Main Forex (Beginner Guide)

Theme: New — most recently published/updated page in the set (July 10–13, 2026)

MEDIUM	Links to the HotForex/HFM review use yet another URL variant here: <code>/brokers/hfm-review/</code> — a fourth link target for the same broker across the pages audited (others used <code>/brokers/hotforex-review/</code>). Confirm which slug is actually canonical and fix the rest to match.
MEDIUM	Three inline images resolve to blank placeholder SVGs (see link table, item 6) — worth confirming in a live browser that the account-demo screenshot, forex-concept diagram, and "deposit" image are actually rendering for visitors.
LOW	This is the strongest content page in the set — clear structure, a real 7-step framework, an honest "most retail traders lose money" disclosure, FAQ schema-friendly formatting, and up-to-date 2026 dating. It also correctly separates "legal" from "safe," which is a nuance the older broker pages don't really address. Worth using as the house style/template going forward once the theme is unified.
LOW	Footer "Broker Terbaik" link still wrong here too (points to <code>/brokers/tifia-review/</code>) — same as Sitewide Issue 1.3.

4. Action Checklist

Fix now (breaks trust or loses traffic)

- Replace the exposed Hostinger staging hostname in the Tickmill page footer with forexmalaysia.com.my — then grep the rest of the new-theme pages/templates for the same staging URL.
- Fix the FxPro page's "Justforex" → should read "FxPro" (mid-page platform-list sentence).
- Decide on one canonical URL + display name for the HotForex/HFM broker and 301-redirect the others (currently 4 different link targets in use across the audited pages: [hotforex-review](#), [hfm-review](#), and two different label texts).

Fix soon (consistency & polish)

- Unify the site on one theme — decide whether the new theme (Tickmill/AvaTrade/Cara Main Forex style) or the old WordPress/HitMag theme is the target, then migrate the rest of the pages.
- Fix the "Broker Terbaik" footer link (currently → </brokers/tifia-review/>) across all new-theme pages/templates.
- Standardise "JustMarket" vs "JustMarkets" across URL slug, page title, H1, and nav — pick one.
- Correct the XM account-type count/list mismatch on the Broker Forex Terbaik page (three vs four accounts).
- Update AvaTrade's 2020-dated trader stats and remove/replace the 2021 "Double Raya Rewards" promo link and image.
- Update the JustMarket account-opening links to consistently use the current JustMarkets domain (drop the legacy justforex.com referral link, or clearly label it as the old brand).
- Fix the typos flagged per-page above (tersembunyi, dagagangan, dikawal-selian, "da support@", "danTelefon").
- Confirm the 3 placeholder/blank images on Cara Main Forex and the licensing-section images on Tickmill are actually rendering in a live browser check.

Worth reconsidering (editorial/strategy)

- Decide whether the Tickmill page's repeated "we recommend XM/JustMarkets/FBS instead" disclaimer should really appear five times, or once in a clearly-labelled verdict box — as written it works against the page's own conversion goal.
- Consider replacing the homepage's raw chronological blog feed with a curated "best brokers / latest reviews" layout, consistent with the newer pages' more commercial intent.
- Audit the rest of the ~30 broker review URLs in the nav menu for the same staging-domain, broken-link, and naming issues found here — this sample suggests the pattern is systemic rather than isolated to the 9 pages requested.

Note: this audit was performed by fetching each page's live HTML/text content. Visual rendering issues (CSS glitches, mobile layout, actual broken-image display) are flagged where the fetched data strongly suggests them, but a manual browser pass is recommended to confirm anything marked accordingly above.
